The City Museum



Occupying three floors and over 500,000 square feet of the former International Shoe Company, the City Museum is a unique special event venue. Built in 1997, the City Museum is a fantasyland made up of unique, found objects from around St. Louis.

Vault Room: 200

First Floor/Mezzanine

Experience an oceanic wonderland. Mermaids and sea creatures swirl around the mosaic floors and columns. A triple level tree stage and dance floor area, perfect for a band, presentation or champagne toast! Native Missouri fish and turtles swim in the 5,000-gallon aquarium ornamented with oyster shells, found sea glass and mosaic tiles. Above the first floor mosaics and aquarium, the mezzanine level also overlooks a two-story waterfall and goldfish pool.

Maximum Seating: 100



Vault Room

Be sure to visit the one-of-a-kind Vault room located on the second floor. Your guests will enter through the old Mercantile Bank vault door and see this 1920s-era building designed for the Roberts, Johnson and Rand Shoe Company as a manufacturing and warehouse facility for its shoe production.

Maximum Seating: 200



Architecture Hall

The third floor showcases City Museum's largest event space, Architecture Hall, featuring a turn of the century bar from St. Louis' Hill neighborhood and a vintage wooden dance floor. This space is framed by the exterior of an old school building from North St. Louis. This space opens into Architecture Museum, providing gallery space for your event.

World's Fair Pavilion



Sitting high atop Government Hill in Forest park, overlooking a fabulous fountain with views of the Saint Louis Zoo and Forest Park Golf Course, is the World's Fair Pavilion. This covered, open-air Pavilion has been one of the more popular and impressive attractions since being built in 1909, with funds generated from the 1904 World's Fair. The Pavilion offers a beautiful view of the park and its picturesque setting lends itself to receptions, benefits, World's Fair-themed picnics, and other special events.

Saint Louis Zoo

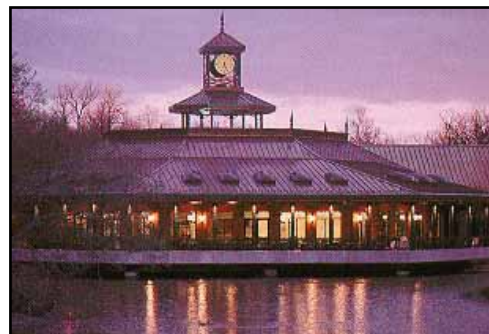
The Saint Louis Zoo provides an unforgettable setting for your event. With three event facilities to choose from the Zoo provides a unique backdrop for any event.



The Living World

To access the Lakeside Café your guests will enter through the South Gate and stroll down the newly-renovated boardwalk.
